Students are expected to follow the Student Conduct and Disciplinary Code.

AWH College of Education aims to cultivate higher values of honesty, integrity, responsibility, respect for person, property, and human rights among students. In order to achieve the same, students shall abide by the rules and regulations of the college. Students should report to the campus at 9 AM and remain on campus until 4 PM.

- 1. Students should report to the campus at 9 AM and remain on campus until 4.15 PM
- 2. Attendance will be taken at 9 AM. Three late arrivals will be marked as one day of leave.
- 3. Students should submit leave applications in the prescribed format one day prior. In case of unforeseen absence, the leave application must be submitted the next day.
- 4. If a student takes leave due to illness, they must submit a medical certificate.
- 5. Students must secure at least 85% attendance to be eligible for the University Examination.
- 6. Students must be regular and punctual in attending sessions and college activities.
- 7. Absence from any session will be considered as half-day leave.
- 8. Students are expected to submit all tasks, assignments, and practical work on time. Failure to do so will result in a deduction of internal marks. Absence from practicals will be taken seriously. No separate practicals will be arranged for absentees.
- 9. The use of mobile phones, iPods, iPhones, or similar devices during instructional hours is strictly restricted to academic purposes only. Any misuse will result in penalties.
- 10. Silence must be maintained in the library and computer labs. Library books should be handled with care. Students must follow all rules regarding the issue and return of library books.
- 11. Ragging in any form is strictly prohibited as per the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India. Any student found guilty of ragging will face severe penalties, including immediate expulsion from the college.
- 12. Students are expected to adhere to the dress code prescribed by the institution while on campus. Strict disciplinary action will be taken against those who violate the dress code. Any change from the dress code is permitted only with the consent of the Principal for special occasions.
- 13. College properties should be handled with maximum care. Students must make every effort to maintain cleanliness and tidiness of the building, furniture, library, buses, and other premises. Fines will be imposed for any damages caused to equipment, furniture, or the building.
- 14. Students are encouraged to minimize the use of single-use plastic items such as chocolate wrappers and plastic carry bags. It is essential to follow sustainable practices and adopt an eco-friendly lifestyle while on campus.
